INFORMATION SECURITY MANAGER POSITION REQUIREMENTS

1. Job Description.

Information Security Manager must be a leader with serious knowledge of information security. His responsibilities include managing team of information security specialists and customer relationships, working with different business units to ensure maintenance of security. Information Security Manager is also responsible for managing security controls for the safeguarding of information assets, ensuring compliance and overall planning, leading, and coordinating information security solution.

Main responsibilities:

- Provide strategic vision for organization information security;
- Define, develop, review, deliver and maintain information security policy, processes and procedures;
- Identify security requirements and ensure the security requirements are met;
- Recommend, implement and lead enterprise level security solutions;
- Ensure best practices and security requirements are employed for the company;
- Measure compliance and ensure retaining certification when needed;

2. Required Education.

Usually Bachelor's degree required in Computer Science, Information Technology or related field.

3. Required Skills & Working Experience.

- Ability to communicate and collaborate effectively across the organization;

- Ability to communication complex technical problems in business terms;
- Ability to effectively engage prospective customers to build trust and relationships, clearly communicate solutions and concepts, and influence action;
- Solid knowledge of security management controls;
- Experience with the regulatory compliance mandates and certifications;
- Ability to select and apply industry standard best practices;
- Ability to self-educate across a variety of IT security related subjects

4. Personal Qualities.

Employers usually require this personal qualities:

- Leadership;
- Sociability;
- Strategic thinking;
- Organizational Skills;
- Teamwork;
- Decisiveness;
- Ability to work with minimal supervision;
- Motivation.
