INFORMATION RISK MANAGER POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Job Description

Information risk managers play a key role in overseeing the use of technology within a company. Their role includes identifying potential risks and developing protocols that staff must follow to reduce or manage those risks. Part of their job involves ensuring that IT systems are structured in a way that is effective for the company's business goals. Information risk managers then monitor the IT systems to ensure that they are secure, and, if an attack occurs, it is their responsibility to make sure that the systems are not breached. Information risk managers are not simply focused on external threats to data. They manage all relevant risk factors, such as the risk of a system failure or loss of data.

2. Required Education

Bachelor degree and relevant education in Information Security, Information risk management, Computer Science or closely related field.

3. Required Skills + Working Experience

Computer skills are essential for this information technology position.

Additionally, Information risk managers need to have analytical skills in order to assess information and identify potential risks. They also need problem-solving skills to be able to determine how to reduce those risks. Communication skills are important, because they must develop clear protocols, inform management about potential risk issues and relay information about policy changes effectively. Business skills are also important, because Information risk managers operate in a business

environment and must consider business goals and objectives when determining how IT systems should operate or what guidelines should be in place to protect the company.
